




COVID-19 confirmed cases by types of transmissions (as of 12.8.2020, 11:00 pm) n=361








Summary of COVID-19 confirmed cases (as of 12.8.2020), n (contacts)= 5,789








Summary of new confirmed cases detection after first two cases (as of 12.8.2020)
