






Map showing COVID-19 laboratory confirmed cases




COVID-19 confirmed cases by types of transmissions (as of 2-6-2020,01:30 am) n=228




Total laboratory confirmed cases by date (as of 2.6.2020, 01:30 am), n = 228

Summary of COVID-19 confirmed cases (as of 2-6-2020) ,n (contacts)= 4,767






COVID-19 confirmed cases among tested by date (as of 1.6.2020)

Summary of new confirmed cases detection after first two cases (as of 2.5.2020)



- Confirmed cases were detected as peak in the 4th week after first confirmed cases due to religious event cluster.
- Confirmed cases were decreased but still raised than the first 3 weeks due to religious event cluster and workplace cluster.
- There were an increased in numbers of cases in the 7th week after the first two cases due to household cluster linked with religious cluster.
- Confirmed cases were detected by nearly two fold rise in the 9th and 10th weeks after first two cases because of returnees coming back by relief flights.
