









# Summary of recovered (as of 15.5.2020)

- Recovered 95 (52 .1% among confirmed cases)
- Active 81 (44.5 % among confirmed cases)
- Death—6 (3.3 % among confirmed cases)
- Among recovered,
  - Symptomatic 49 % and asymptomatic 51 %
  - 2 % of cases have severe symptoms and others have mild.
  - ♦ Minimum age 1 year and 6 month
  - ♦ Maximum age 87 year

Recovery time means having at least 2 consecutive sets of nasopharyngeal and throat swabs collected ≥ 24 hours apart from a patient a patient with COVID-19 (a total of four negative specimens) and resolving of fever without use of antipyretic medication, improvement in illness signs and symptoms.
