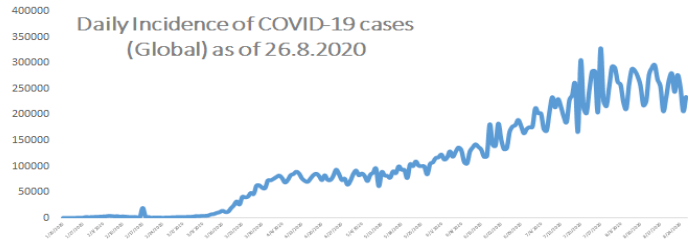

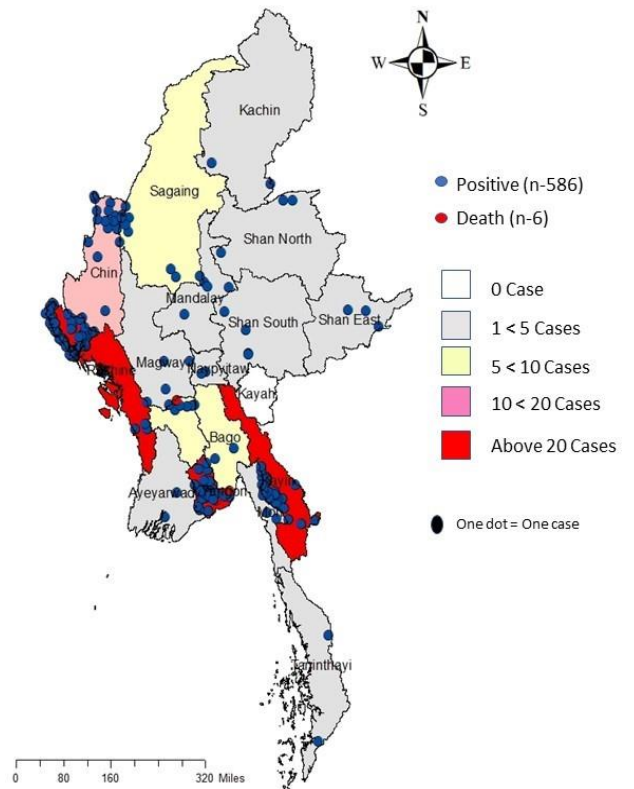

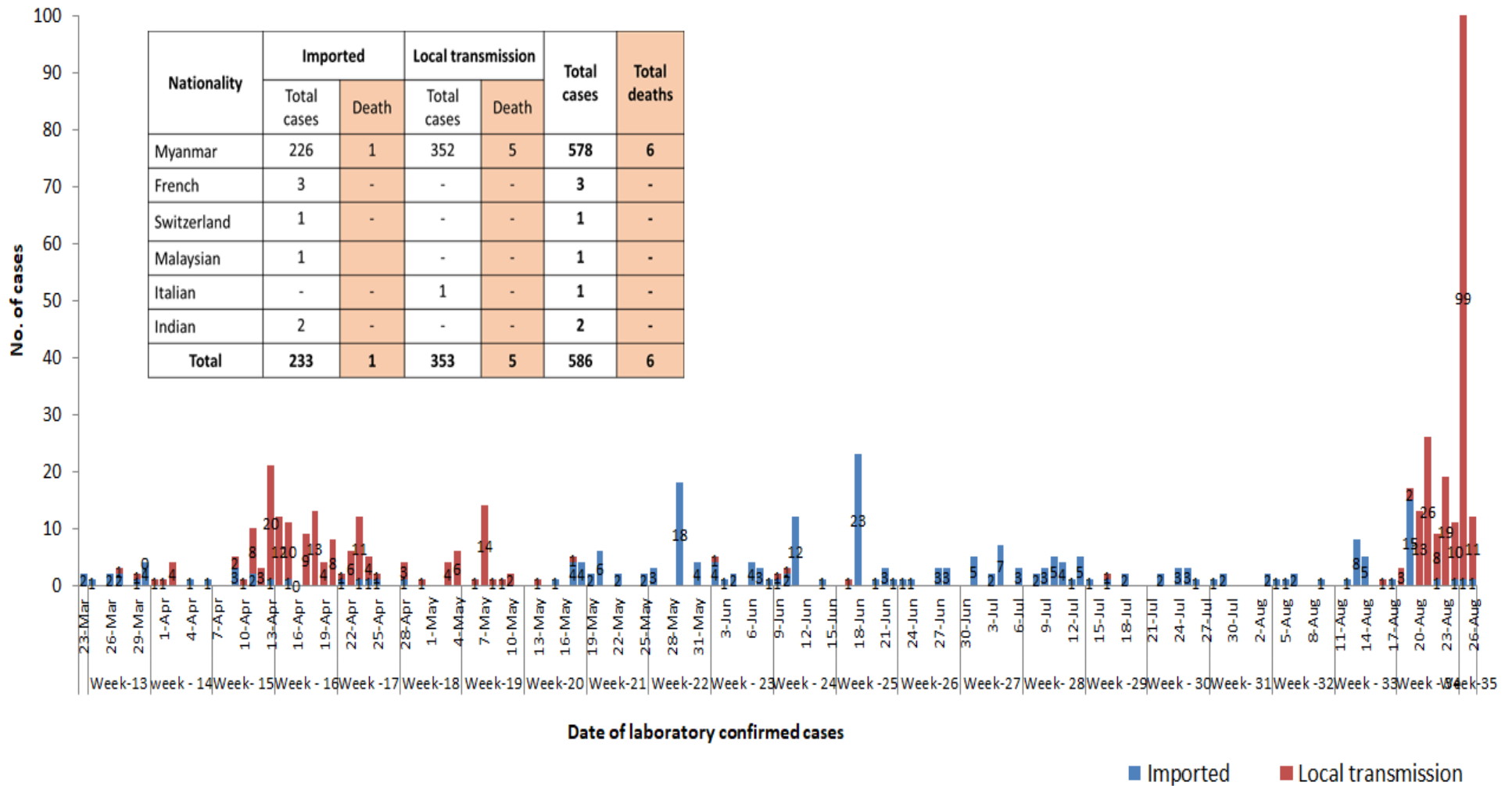

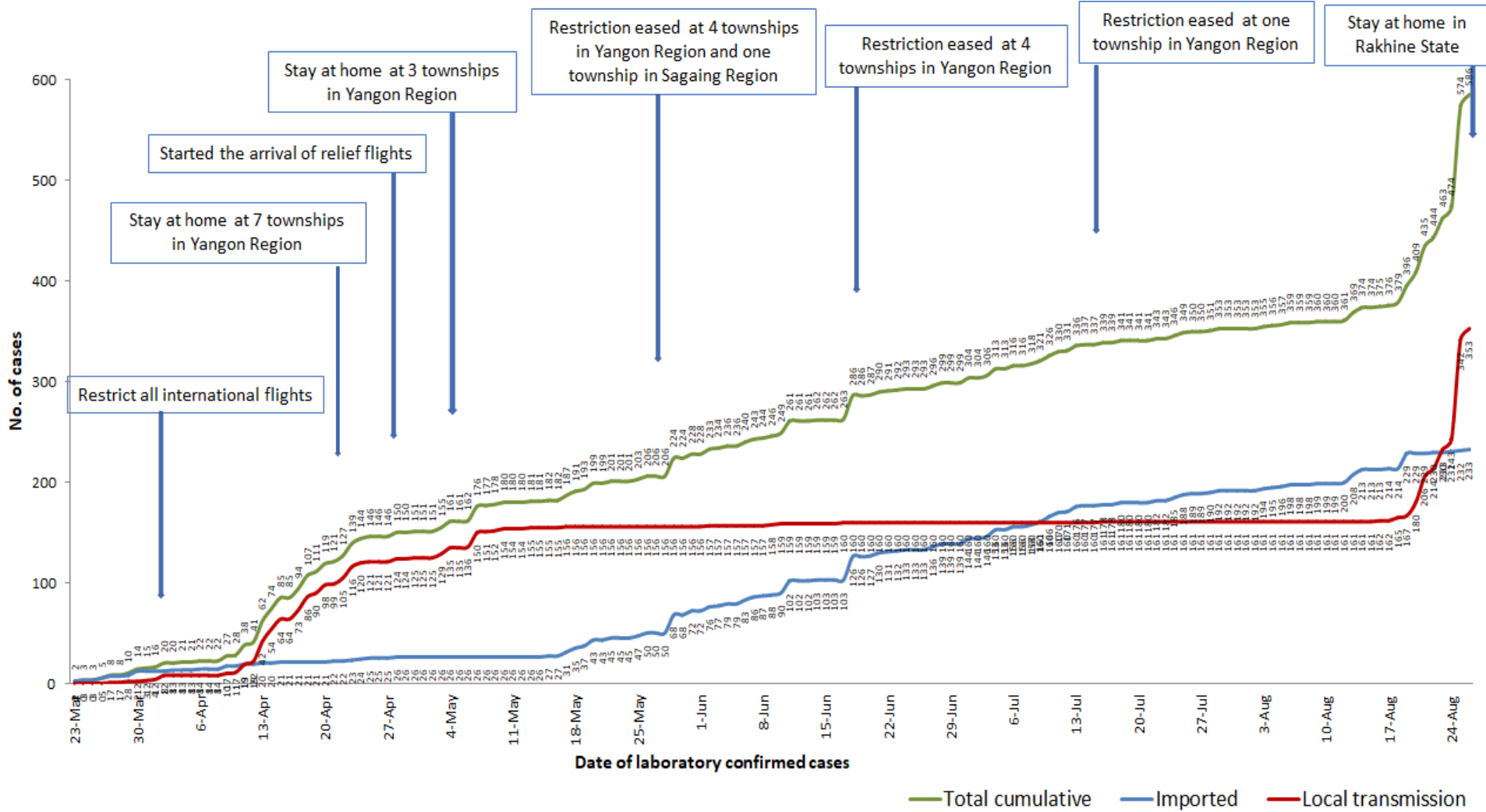
Map showing COVID-19 laboratory confirmed cases



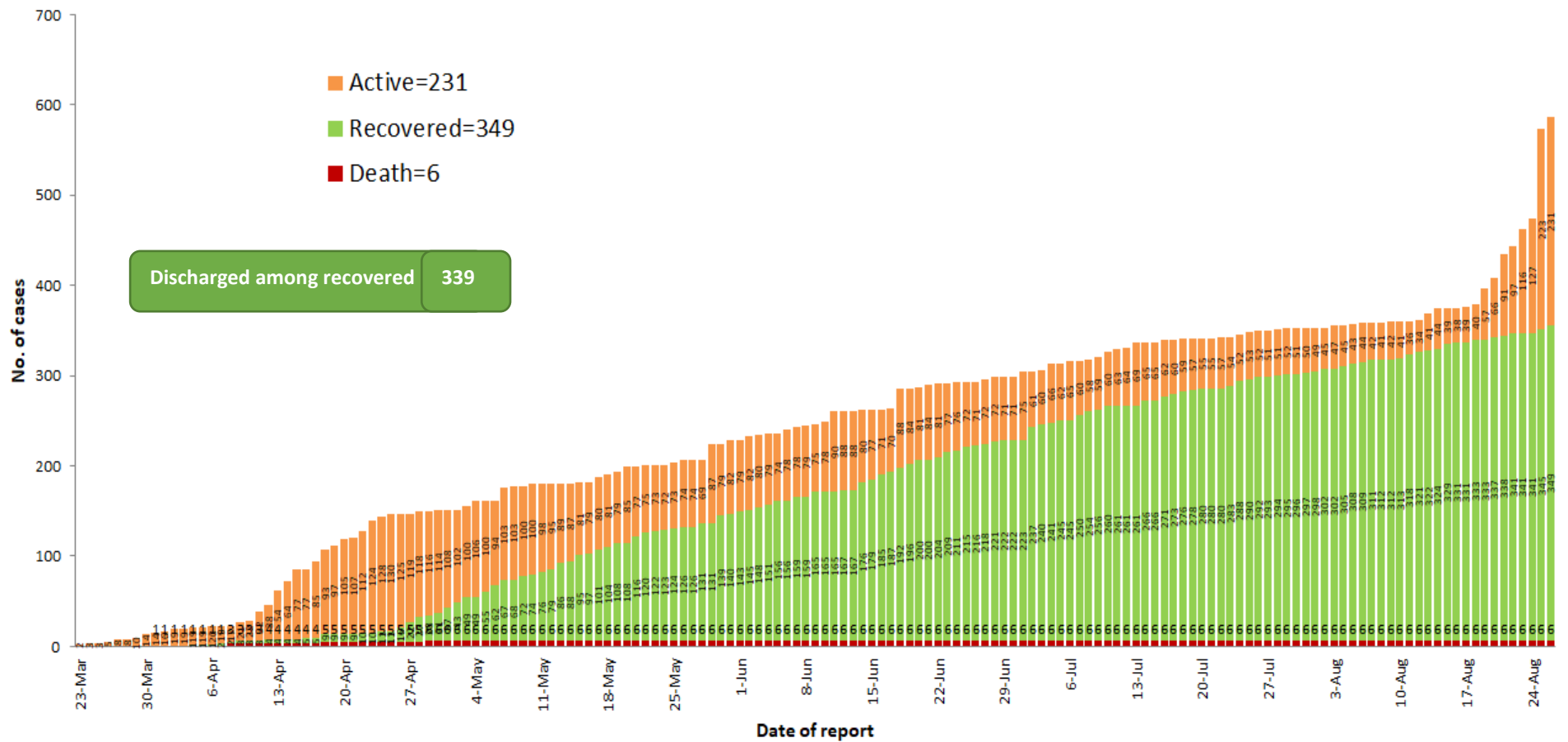
COVID-19 confirmed cases by types of transmissions (as of 26.8.2020) n=586



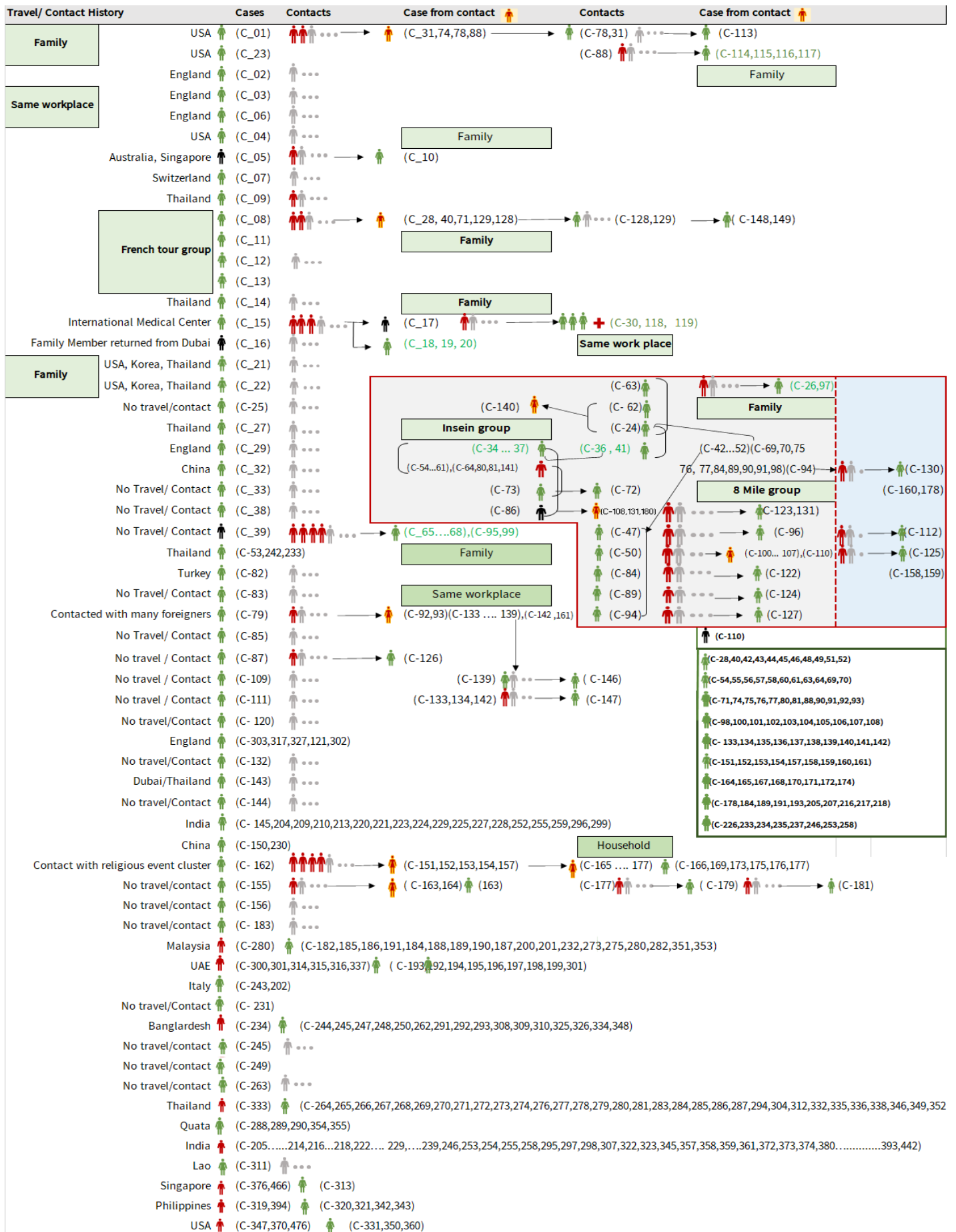
Total laboratory confirmed cases by date (as of 26.8.2020), n= 586



Cumulative Number of active confirmed cases, recovered and deaths (23.3.2020 – 26.8.2020), n (cumulative)=586

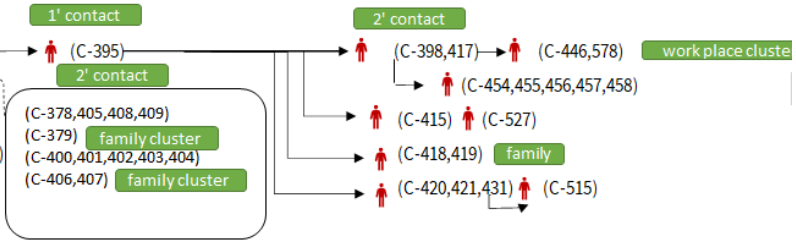

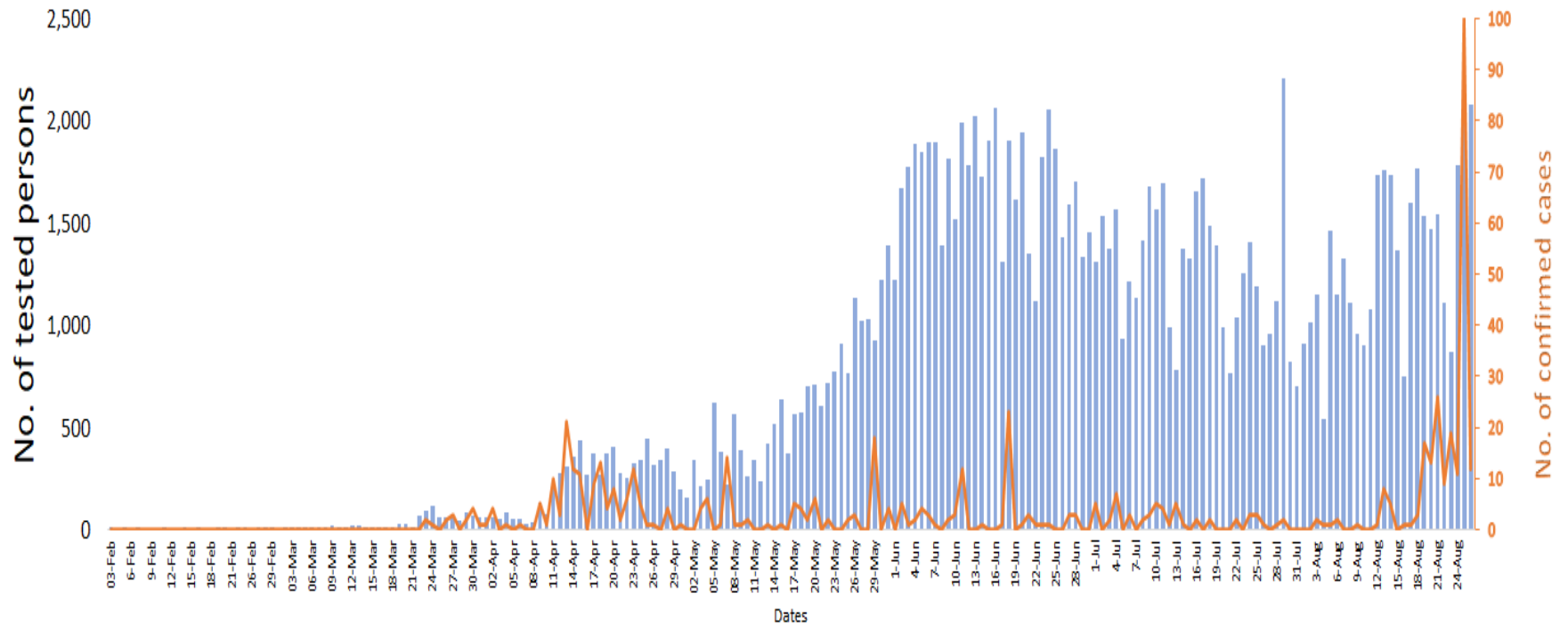

COVID-19 confirmed cases among tested by date (as of 26.8.2020)

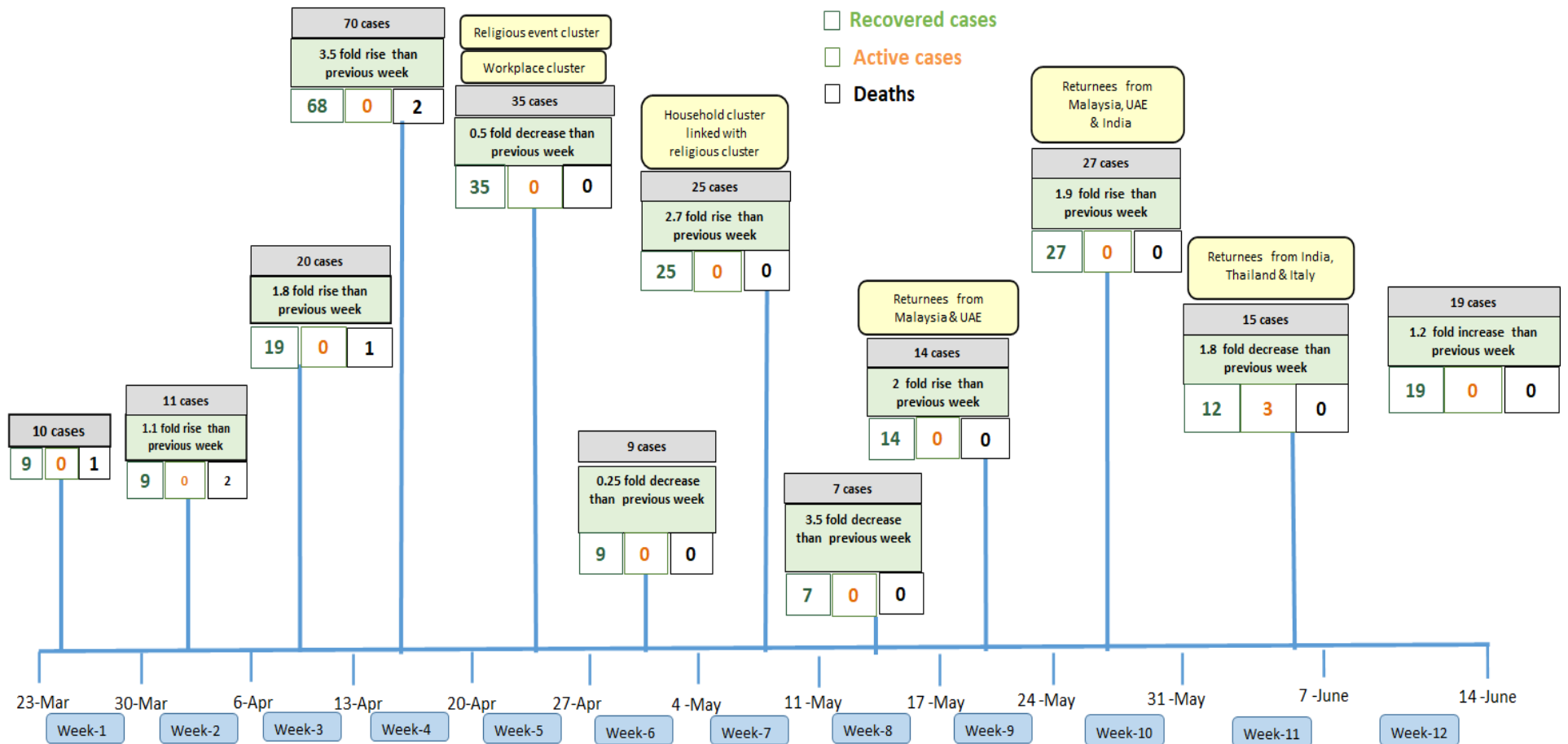

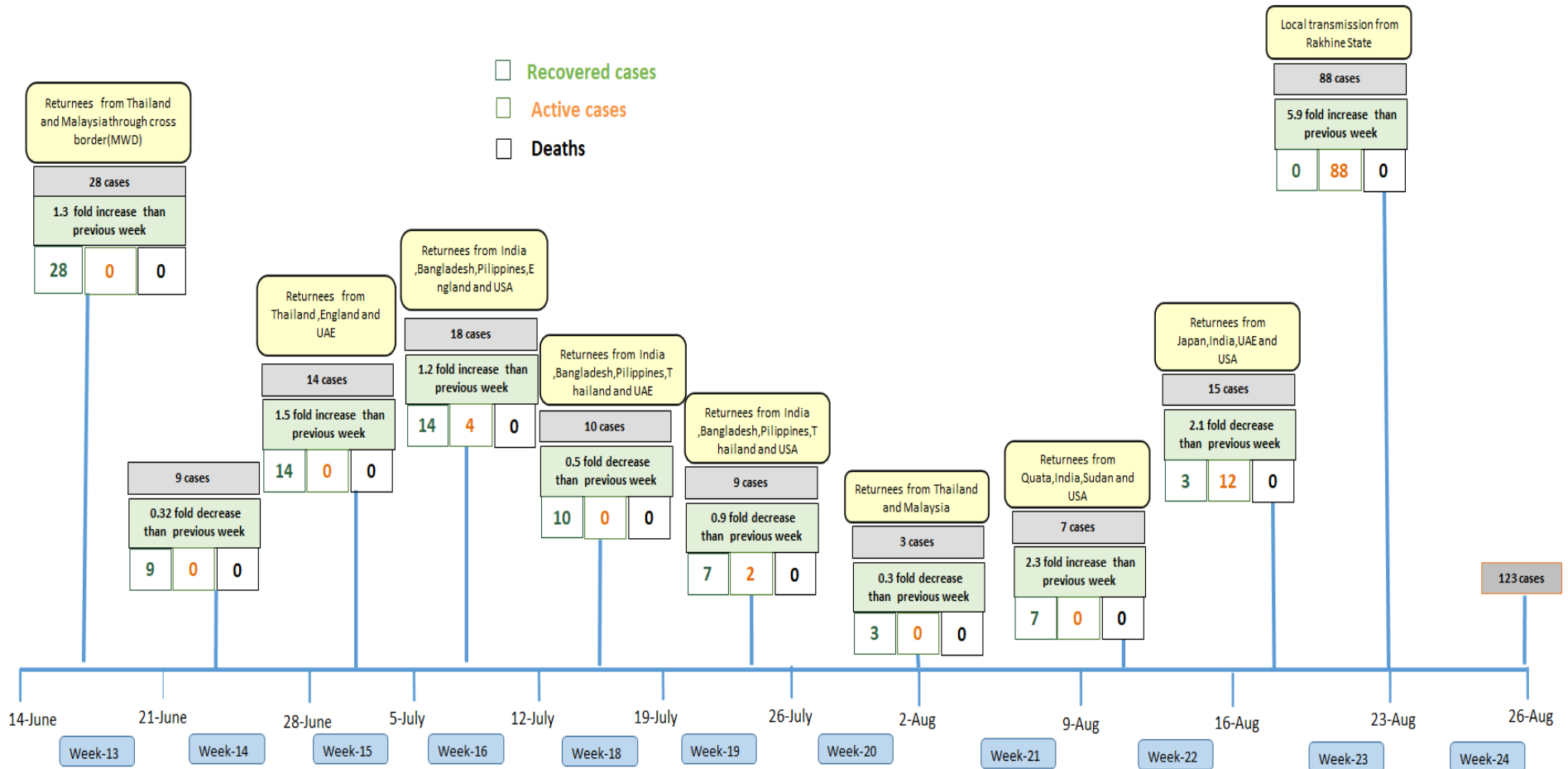

Summary of new confirmed cases detection after first two cases (as of 26.8.2020)



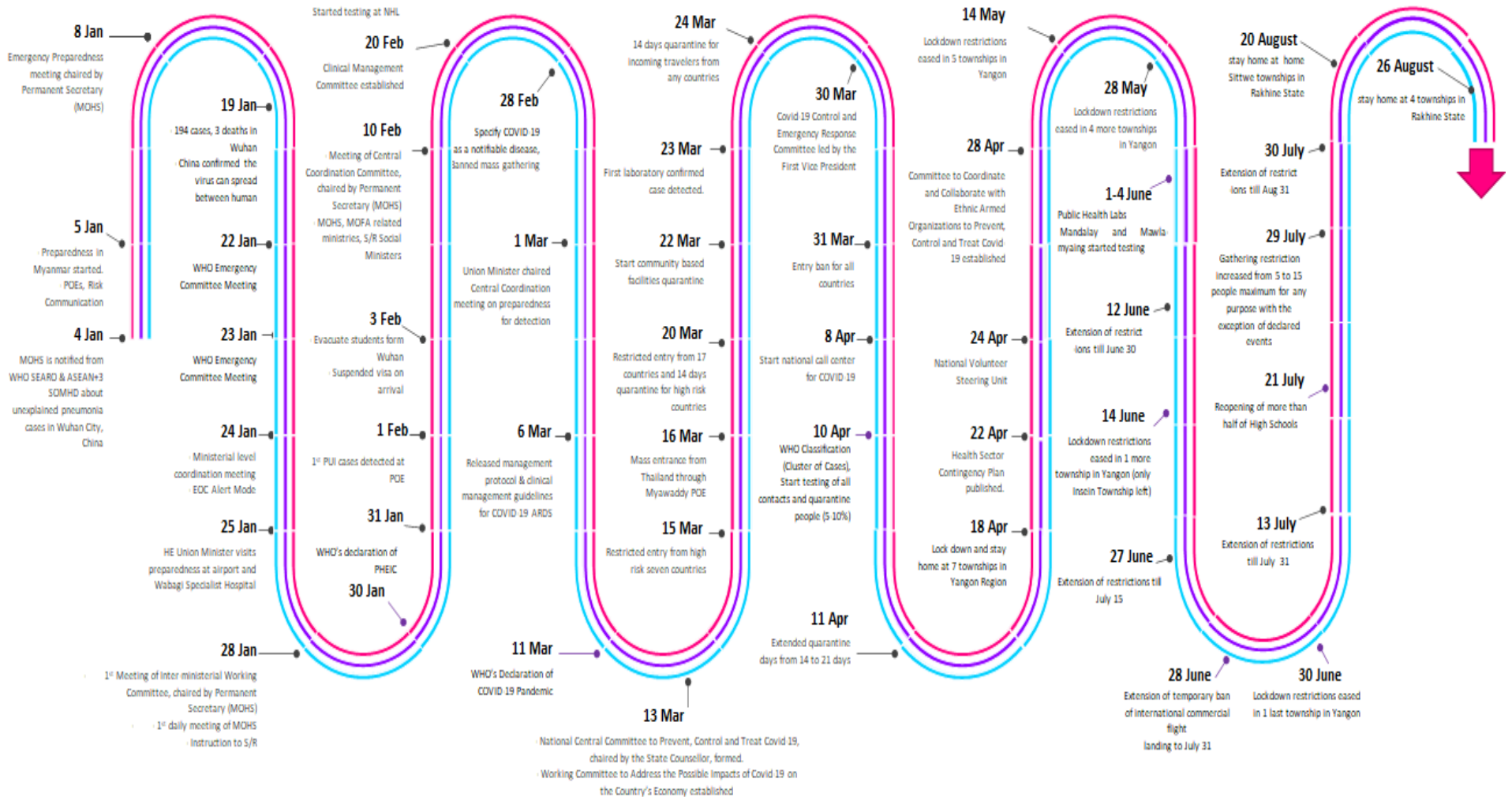
- Confirmed cases were detected as a peak in the 4th week after first confirmed cases due to the religious event cluster.
- Confirmed cases were decreased but still raised than the first 3 weeks due to the religious event cluster and workplace cluster.
- There were an increased in numbers of cases in the 7th week after the first two cases due to the household cluster linked with a religious cluster.
- Confirmed cases were detected by a nearly two-fold rise in the 9th and 10th weeks after the first two cases because of returnees coming back by relief flights.
