Announcement of lifting precautionary restrictions for travellers from the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland visiting Myanmar

## 31<sup>st</sup> August 2021

- 1. The Ministry of Health has imposed the temporary travel restrictions on residents of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and travelers who had visited the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland during the last 14 days, from visiting Myanmar as precautionary measures to control and limit the risk of transmission of the new SARS-CoV-2 variant to Myanmar on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020.
- 2. The Ministry of Health is continuously monitoring the global epidemiological situation on COVID-19 and it is found that COVID-19 situation becomes stable as well as COVID-19 vaccination coverage in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland is remarkably high.
- 3. Therefore, the Ministry of Health will lift temporary ban on residents of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and travelers who had visited the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland during the last 14 days, from visiting Myanmar. The measure will take effect starting from 31<sup>st</sup> August 2021, *2359 hours* MST.
