Announcement of lifting precautionary restrictions for travellers from the Republic of India and the People's Republic of Bangladesh visiting Myanmar

24th September 2021

1. The Ministry of Health has imposed the temporary travel restrictions on residents of the Republic of India and the People's Republic of Bangladesh and travelers who had visited the Republic of India and the People's Republic of Bangladesh during the last 14 days, from visiting Myanmar as precautionary measures to control and limit the risk of transmission of the new SARS-CoV-2 variant to Myanmar on 27th April 2021.

2. The Ministry of Health is continuously monitoring the global epidemiological situation on COVID-19 and it is found that COVID-19 transmission and situation becomes stable in the Republic of India and the People's Republic of Bangladesh since July 2021.

3. Therefore, the Ministry of Health will lift temporary ban on residents of the Republic of India and the People's Republic of Bangladesh and travelers who had visited the Republic of India and the People's Republic of Bangladesh during the last 14 days, from visiting Myanmar. The **measure** will take effect starting from 24th September 2021, 2359 *hours* MST.
