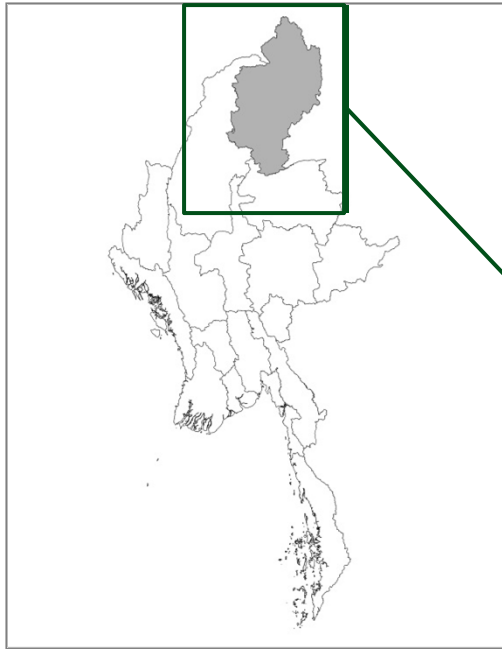




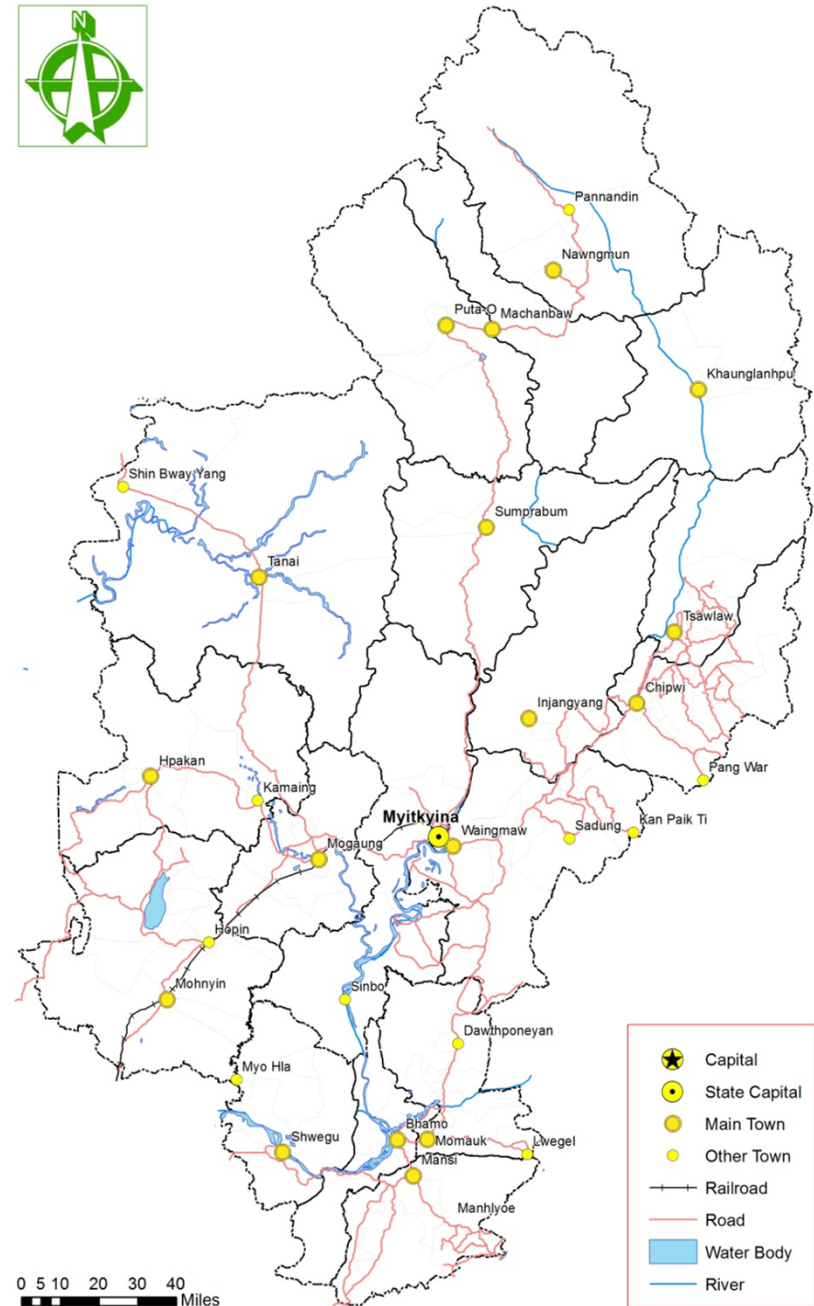

## **Resettlement and health care service**

As a durable solution for IDP, Kachin State Government had planned to establish new villages.

One village namely Ngwe Pyaw Sanpya Village is established in Myitkyina and people of IDP camps in Myitkyina and Waningmaw were placed in 2015.

Another resettlement area was at Sein Lon Gabar village in Moemauk Township.

For health care service, temporary clinics are opened by BHS from nearest Sub-RHCs of Myintkyina and Moemauk townships.

## **Other services provisions at the IDP camps**

- Apart from health and nutrition led by MoHS,
- the respective government departments, UNs, INGOs and local NGOs are supporting to basic needs of IDPs at the camps, i.e shelter, non-food items, WASH, food security, education and protection, etc.
- To support for the livelihood activities of the displaced people, the vocational trainings (driving and sewing, etc) are provided led by Relief and Resettlement Department and Social Welfare Department
